**Secretary Minutes:** March 1, 2022 (Anne Mosakowski, Interim Secretary)

**Treasurer's Report:** Harry Hill III reviewed the operating budget (7-1-22 to 6-30-23) as of March 31, 2023.

- Revenue/Income \$16,852.98 (Budgeted \$20,100.00) Expenses \$5,575.45 (Budgeted \$20,100.00)
- Investment Account as of December 31, 2022 \$94,263.08 (down \$13,035.14 from December 2021). The next statement will come at the end of March and is not yet available.
- Discussed donations under miscellaneous is year to date \$3,918.00. Encourage people to donate but note that donations are not tax deductible. Consider looking into tax deductible status.
- Budget was filed for audit
- Treasurer/Budget duties will transfer from current Treasurer Harry Hill III to Dr. Janice
  Hoffman/Willis at the end of the Fiscal Year June 30, 2023 and officially begin July 1,
  2023. A motion was passed at the March 1, 2023 meeting by voice vote. Janice asked
  those in attendance to think about budget items and that the June meeting will be a budget
  meeting.
